Lightning 3 vs. New Jersey 2

The Lightning improved to 2-0-0 to start 2016-17 with a comeback win over New Jersey, the Bolts fifth-consecutive regular season victory over the Devils...Tampa Bay captain **Steven Stamkos** scored his first goal of the season to get the Bolts on the board at 7:53 of the second period...**Alex Killorn** tied the game 2:14 after Stamkos' marker...**Valtteri Filppula** netted the game-winner on a tip of **Jason Garrison's** shot from the point at 5:43 of the third...**Andrei Vasilevskiy** stopped 32-of-34 shots to win in his season debut...The Lightning rallied from a 2-0 deficit for a second-straight game...Bolts defenseman **Braydon Coburn** skated in his 700th career NHL game (576 games with PHI, 86 with TBL, 38 with ATL)...Bolts forward **J.T. Brown** played in his 200th career league game (all with the Lightning)...Bolts rookie Brayden Point tallied his first career NHL point (second assist on game-winner).

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP

The Lightning are playing the first of four meetings this season against in-state rival Florida tonight...The Bolts went 1-3-1 against the Panthers in 2015-16, the lone victory coming at AMALIE Arena on Jan. 16, 2017, a 3-1 win...In that victory, **Nikita Kucherov** had a pair of goals and **Ben Bishop** stopped 26-of-27 shots he faced...Tampa Bay outshot Florida 174-132 combined in the five games last season...The Lightning have won five of their last seven games at home against Florida...Tampa Bay is 29-21-6 with six ties all-time at home versus Florida...The Lightning are 50-50-12 with 10 ties all-time overall against the Panthers.

TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

The Lightning are looking to start 3-0-0 for the second-straight season and fifth time in franchise history (also: 2015-16, 2010-11, 2007-08, 2003-04, 2002-03)...The Bolts are playing the third game of a season-opening four-game home stand to start 2016-17...The Lightning are 2-0-0 at AMALIE Arena so far in 2016-17; last season, the Bolts finished 25-13-3 at home, the 25 wins tied for second most in franchise history (1st: 32 in 2014-15)...Tampa Bay's 25 home wins last season were tied for seventh most in the NHL...The Lightning have won 25 or more games at home five of the last six seasons (the only season not to do it was the 2012-13 lockout-shortened season)...The Bolts play 12 of their first 18 games away from AMALIE Arena to start 2016-17.

WORLD CUP OF LIGHTNING

Tampa Bay had 12 players compete at the World Cup of Hockey in Toronto during the offseason, more than any other team in the NHL...Additionally, Lightning head coach **Jon Cooper** served as an assistant coach for Team North America, and **Ryan Callahan** was selected for Team USA but could not compete due to injury...Eight different Bolts scored a goal at the WCH, including **Valtteri Filppula**, who notched the only goal of the tournament for Team Finland...**Steven Stamkos** scored a goal in the first game of a best-of-3 final versus Team Europe to help lead Team Canada to the tournament championship.

COMEBACK KIDS

The Lightning have rallied from a two-goal deficit in each of their first two games...Per Elias, the Bolts overcame a multi-goal deficit to win in consecutive games for the first time since March 2 (4-3 OT win vs. NYR) and March 3 (4-3 OT win at CAR) during the 2011-12 season...The Lightning only overcame a multi-goal deficit three times in 2015-16: Oct. 12 at BOS (trailed 2-0, won 6-3), Dec. 15 at TOR (trailed 3-1, won 5-4 OT) and Jan. 8 at EDM (trailed 2-0, won 3-2)...The Bolts' comebacks are part of a larger trend this season in the NHL: Per Elias, 11 of 36 total games (through 10/17) have seen a team earn at least one point after trailing by multiple goals (including 9 wins).

STAMMER TIME

Tampa Bay captain **Steven Stamkos** scored his first goal of 2016-17 in the Bolts' victory Oct. 15 vs. NJD, his second-straight game with a point to start the season...Going back to last season, Stamkos has recorded at least a point in nine of the last 12 games he's played (8 goals, 6 assists)...Stamkos ranks T-10th in the NHL for shots per game (4.5) and T-23rd for total shots (9)...Stamkos led the Lightning in goals for the second-straight season and sixth time in the last seven seasons after netting 36 in 2015-16...Stamkos ranked T-7th in the NHL for goals last season...Stamkos returns for his ninth season with the Bolts after signing an eight-year contract extension on June 29, 2016...Since entering the league in 2008-09, Stamkos has scored more goals (313) than anybody in the NHL except WSH's **Alex Ovechkin** (362).

JOHNNY ON THE SPOT

Lightning center **Tyler Johnson** assisted on **Alex Killorn's** game-tying goal Oct. 15 vs. NJD, his second-straight game with a point to open 2016-17...Johnson needs three more assists to reach 100 for his NHL career...Dating back to last postseason, Johnson has recorded at least a point in five of his last seven games (4 goals, 2 assists)...Johnson leads the Lightning and ranks T-16th in the NHL for face-off wins (26)...Johnson ranks T-8th in the NHL for face-off win percentage (minimum 10 face-offs) at 65% (won 26 of 40 face-offs).

KILLING THEM SOFTLY

Tampa Bay Lightning: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: Jon Cooper

Cooper was named Tampa Bay's eighth head coach on March 26, 2013.

Cooper, 49, begins his fifth season as Lightning head coach and has amassed a 146-90-25 record entering 2016-17. Cooper's .607 win percentage is the highest in franchise history. He earned NHL victory No. 100 on April 11, 2015, making him the fifth-fastest coach among those who debuted in the NHL since 2000 to reach the mark. He led the Bolts to the Stanley Cup Playoffs in each of his three full seasons as head coach, including back-to-back Eastern Conference Finals (2015, 2016) and a Stanley Cup Final (2015). He was a finalist for the Jack Adams Award in 2014, given annually to the NHL's top coach. Cooper joined the Lightning after spending the previous three seasons behind the bench of Tampa Bay's top minor league affiliates, the Norfolk Admirals (2010-12) and the Syracuse Crunch (2012-13), compiling a 133-62-26 (.661) record in 221 AHL games. Cooper's NHL head coaching debut came with the Lightning on March 29, 2013.

Gerard Gallant was named head coach of the Florida Panthers on June 21, 2014.

In 2015-16, Gallant led the Panthers to a franchise record 47 wins and 103 points securing an Atlantic Division title and the franchise's first playoff berth since 2011-12.
