The Rangers play their ninth game of the 2016-17 season and begin a three-game homestand tonight, Oct. 30, against the Tampa Bay Lightning at Madison Square Garden (7:00 p.m. ET - TV: MSG Network; Radio: ESPN 98.7 FM). Including tonight's game, the Rangers will play five of their next six games at MSG. The Blueshirts have won three of their last four games (3-1-0 record) and have posted a 5-3-0 record this season.

The Blueshirts have earned at least one point in 65 of their last 85 home games, dating back to Oct. 16, 2014 (56-20-9 record). In addition, the Rangers have posted a 31-11-4 record at MSG since the start of last season. The Rangers are tied for the NHL lead in wins (31), and they lead the NHL in goals for (151) and goals per game (3.28) at home since the start of last season.

McDonagh is tied for second in the NHL in assists this season (seven), and he is one of four NHL defensemen who have recorded seven assists in 2016-17 (along with Duncan Keith, Ryan Suter, and Rasmus Ristolainen).

WELCOME MATS

Mats Zuccarello tallied both of the Rangers' goals on Oct. 28 at Carolina, and he is tied for the team lead with four goals this season. Zuccarello has recorded six points (three goals, three assists) and has posted a plus-four rating in the last six games.

VESEY DOES IT

Jimmy Vesey leads NHL rookies in game-winning goals (two) and is tied for third among NHL rookies in goals (four) this season. Vesey is one of four NHL rookies who have recorded four or more goals in 2016-17 (along with Auston Matthews, Patrik Laine, and William Nylander).

MIKA MAGIC

Mika Zibanejad has tallied a point in six of the first eight games this season, and he leads the Rangers in points in 2016-17 (eight).

Tampa Bay Lightning: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: Jon Cooper

Cooper was named Tampa Bay's eighth head coach on March 26, 2013.

Cooper, 49, begins his fifth season as Lightning head coach and has amassed a 146-90-25 record entering 2016-17. Cooper's .607 win percentage is the highest in franchise history. He earned NHL victory No. 100 on April 11, 2015, making him the fifth-fastest coach among those who debuted in the NHL since 2000 to reach the mark. He led the Bolts to the Stanley Cup Playoffs in each of his three full seasons as head coach, including back-to-back Eastern Conference Finals (2015, 2016) and a Stanley Cup Final (2015). He was a finalist for the Jack Adams Award in 2014, given annually to the NHL's top coach. Cooper joined the Lightning after spending the previous three seasons behind the bench of Tampa Bay's top minor league affiliates, the Norfolk Admirals (2010-12) and the Syracuse Crunch (2012-13), compiling a 133-62-26 (.661) record in 221 AHL games. Cooper's NHL head coaching debut came with the Lightning on March 29, 2013.
