- **Blueliners:** Including Sunday night's win over Toronto, the Islanders defensemen have recorded a goal in each of the last five games, matching the longest streak for NYI goals from the blueline in 29 years. Last season, the Islanders went 18-8-3 when a defenseman recorded a goal in the game. This season, New York is 3-3-0 when a defenseman finds the back of the net. On 10/23, three NYI defensemen recorded a goal (Boychuk, de Haan, Hickey) making it the first time since Feb. of 2015 three Islanders' blueliners scored in the same game & it's the first time since December 29-31, 2007 that the Isles defense has scored multiple goals in consecutive games. As of 10/27 all active Islanders' defensemen have recorded at least one goal this season.
- **Home Cooking:** From Oct. 16 - Nov. 7, New York will play 10 of their 11 games at home. Through their first 30 games, the Islanders will play 19 home games. The Islanders earned 55 points at home in 2015-16 with a 25-11-5 record at Barclays Center. They equaled their highest home point-total since 2003-04. New York is 3-2-0 at home this season.
- **How the West was Won:** Dating back to last season, the Islanders are 15-1-2 (3-1-0 this season) when playing a Western Conference opponent at Barclays Center. During their current five-game home stand, New York played four Western Conference opponents (ANA, SJS, ARI, MIN) and went 3-1-0.

- **Chimera Seeking 1000:** Newly acquired Islander forward **Jason Chimera** is closing in on his 1000th NHL game. He currently sits at 960 games played, good for 20th among all active NHLers. Chimera made his NHL debut in December of 2000 and over his 16-year NHL career, has played for Edmonton, Columbus, Washington & the Islanders.
- **Captains: John Tavares** is entering his fourth season as the captain of the New York Islanders. Tavares, the Islanders 2009 first overall selection, was named the 14th captain in franchise history in September, 2013. **Andrew Ladd, Cal Clutterbuck & Travis Hamonic** will be the alternate captains for New York this season. Ladd, entering his first season with the Islanders and 12th in the NHL, will wear the 'A' every night, while Clutterbuck & Hamonic will alternate nights with a letter. Ladd was the captain for six seasons with the Atlanta Thrashers/ Winnipeg Jets.
- **Under Capuano:** Jack Capuano enters his seventh season as the Head Coach of the Islanders in 2016-17. He is the NHL's fourth-longest tenured coach, behind Claude Julien, Joel Quenneville and Dave Tippett. Capuano is 214-180-56 in 449 games behind the

Islanders bench. He ranks second on the Islanders all-time list in both games coached (450) and wins (214), behind Al Arbour (1,500 coached, 740 wins).

- **Three's Company:** Last season, the Islanders went 37-4-2 when they scored at least three goals (including shootout winners). This season, New York is 4-1-0 when hitting the three goal mark.

Head Coach: Jack Capuano

Jack Capuano was named the interim head coach of the New York Islanders on November 15, 2010. The Islanders removed the "interim" label from Capuano's title on April 12, 2011.

Entering 2016-17, Capuano ranks second in franchise history with 210 coaching wins (Al Arbour - 740) and 441 games coached (Arbour - 1,500). He was selected as an Assistant Coach for Team USA at the 2016 World Cup of Hockey.

Last season, Capuano led the Islanders to their second-consecutive 100-point campaign, as the Islanders reached the Stanley Cup Playoffs for the third time under the Head Coach.

Capuano first joined the Islanders in 2005-06 as an Assistant Coach. The native of Cranston, RI, was named Head Coach of the Bridgeport Sound Tigers of the American Hockey League on April 30, 2007, where he finished with a 133-100-8-14 record in four seasons.

Capuano began his coaching career in 1995 as an assistant with the Tallahassee Tiger Sharks of the ECHL.

Tampa Bay Lightning: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: Jon Cooper

Cooper was named Tampa Bay's eighth head coach on March 26, 2013.

Cooper, 49, begins his fifth season as Lightning head coach and has amassed a 146-90-25 record entering 2016-17. Cooper's .607 win percentage is the highest in franchise history. He earned NHL victory No. 100 on April 11, 2015, making him the fifth-fastest coach among those who debuted in the NHL since 2000 to reach the mark. He led the Bolts to the Stanley Cup Playoffs in each of his three full seasons as head coach, including back-to-back Eastern Conference Finals (2015, 2016) and a Stanley Cup Final (2015). He was a finalist for the Jack Adams Award in 2014, given annually to the NHL's top coach. Cooper joined the Lightning after spending the previous three seasons behind the bench of Tampa Bay's top minor league affiliates, the Norfolk Admirals (2010-12) and the Syracuse Crunch (2012-13), compiling a 133-62-26 (.661) record in 221 AHL games. Cooper's NHL head coaching debut came with the Lightning on March 29, 2013.
