Tampa Bay Lightning: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: Jon Cooper

Cooper was named Tampa Bay's eighth head coach on March 26, 2013.

Cooper, 49, begins his fifth season as Lightning head coach and has amassed a 146-90-25 record entering 2016-17. Cooper's .607 win percentage is the highest in franchise history. He earned NHL victory No. 100 on April 11, 2015, making him the fifth-fastest coach among those who debuted in the NHL since 2000 to reach the mark. He led the Bolts to the Stanley Cup Playoffs in each of his three full seasons as head coach, including back-to-back Eastern Conference Finals (2015, 2016) and a Stanley Cup Final (2015). He was a finalist for the Jack Adams Award in 2014, given annually to the NHL's top coach. Cooper joined the Lightning after spending the previous three seasons behind the bench of Tampa Bay's top minor league affiliates, the Norfolk Admirals (2010-12) and the Syracuse Crunch (2012-13), compiling a 133-62-26 (.661) record in 221 AHL games. Cooper's NHL head coaching debut came with the Lightning on March 29, 2013.

DEVILS IN DETAIL

HOMELAND

On Oct. 29, the Devils finished a four-game home-stand at Prudential Center. New Jersey won three of their four games with a 2-1 OT victory over the Minnesota Wild, a 5-3 win over the Arizona Coyotes and a 3-1 win over the Tampa Bay Lightning. New Jersey only lost one game, 2-3 OT, to the Chicago Blackhawks on Oct. 28. New Jersey is undefeated in regulation at home, 4-0-1, in 2016-17. The last time the Devils started a season without a regulation loss at home through the first five games was in 2012-13 (5-0-1).

SEVERSON SCORING

Damon Severson leads the Devils in scoring with 1g-7a-8pts through the first nine games of 2016-17. He has 1g-5a-6pts over his last four games. He is ranked ninth (tie, four others) in the NHL in points and tied for third in the league with five power play assists.

SCHNEIDER SAVING

Cory Schneider is ranked 12th in the NHL with a .933 save-percentage and is 12th in the league with a 2.11 goals against average. New Jersey has allowed the fourth-lowest goal-totals in the league with 2.19 goals-against per game.

HIT THE ROAD

The Devils play 11 of their next 15 games in the road. They play 19 of 29 games on the road in November and December. New Jersey is currently 0-2-2 away from Prudential Center this season.

700 CLUB

Travis Zajac appeared in his 700th career game, all with New Jersey, on Oct. 13, 2016. He ranks 13th all-time in games played in Devils' history and is 8th all-time among forwards. He tied **Bruce Driver** for 13th all-time with 702 career games with the Devils on Oct. 18. Zajac ranks 11th all-time in franchise history with 145g-251a-396pts. **Bruce Driver** is 10th all-time with 83g-316a-399pts. Zajac passed **Claude Lemieux** and **Jamie Langenbrunner** (142) for sole possession of 13th all-time in Devils' history for goals on Oct. 25 (2g). Captain **Andy Greene** is the second-most current-tenured Devil, having played in 650 games with New Jersey.

IRON MAN

Andy Greene has skated in 320 consecutive games, dating back to Mar. 6, 2012. On Mar. 31, 2016 at Florida, he passed **Jay Pandolfo** (307 games, Jan. 22, 2003-Nov. 28, 2007) for the fifth-longest games-played stretch in Devils' history. **Kirk Muller** is next on the team's all-time list, having played in 321 consecutive games from Apr. 5, 1987-Mar. 31, 1991. Greene's streak is the second-longest in team history among defensemen, trailing only **Ken Daneyko's** 388 game stretch from Nov. 4, 1989-Mar. 29, 1994.

HALL OF A MONTH

Taylor Hall scored two power play goals (his first two goals with NJ) in his Prudential Center debut Oct. 18. It was his first multi-goal game since Dec. 11, 2015 vs. NYR (2g). He then scored in overtime on Oct. 22 vs. Min. to top-off his three-goal week. On Oct. 25 vs. Arizona, he scored 2g (1 PP, 1 even-strength) and added an assist for his first 3pt. night as a Devil. He added one assist Oct. 28 vs. Chicago to have his first three-game point-streak (3g-2a) as a Devil. Hall is tied for fourth in the NHL with two game-winning goals. In the month of October, Hall scored 5g-2a-7pts in eight games.

TAKE TWO!

Head Coach **John Hynes** is entering his second season as New Jersey's bench boss. Last season the Devils' finished with a 38-36-8 (84pts) record. Hynes also was the head coach for the United States at the 2016 Men's IIHF World Championships where the American's finished fourth. He was an assistant coach for Team USA at the 2016 World Cup of Hockey. **Geoff Ward, Alain Nasreddine** and **Chris Terreri** all returned with Coach Hynes for another season. **Ryane Clowe** was also named as an assistant coach by Hynes during this year's Development Camp. Executive Vice President/General Manager **Ray Shero** and Assistant General Manager **Tom Fitzgerald** are also back for their sophomore season leading the Devils.

In 2008, the Devils defeated the Lightning, 4-3, in a shootout at Prudential Center. **Jamie Langenbrunner** scored the game-deciding goal in the third round of the shootout. **Patrik Elias** had 1g-1a-2pts in the match and **Dainius Zubrus** recorded two assists. **Kevin Weekes** stopped 24 of 27 shots in the win.
