KLINKE, a peace officer, being duly sworn says that there is probable cause to the warrantless arrest of the above named defendant for the charge(s) stated above, arising out of the incidents occurring at,

Adams County, Colorado on 2/2/19 9:07PM that the following facts are true and correct to the best of his/her knowledge, information and belief and support the arrest of the defendant: COPELAND, JOSHUA

On 02-02-2019 at approximately 2115 hours Your Affiant was dispatched to [REDACTED] in the City of Thornton, County of Adams and State of Colorado on report of a Domestic Violence.

On scene I contacted (VI) [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated her Husband (OF) Joshua Copeland (10-20-1982) had punched her in the face. [REDACTED] had an obvious bruise on her left eye, a cut and was bleeding. There was blood down the front of her face and neck as well as down her shirt. [REDACTED] said the argument started in the kitchen over food. [REDACTED] said she took their son (IO) [REDACTED] up to his room. [REDACTED] said Joshua came up stairs a few minutes later and they continued arguing. [REDACTED] said Joshua pushed her and she pushed him back. [REDACTED] said Joshua pushed her to the ground. [REDACTED] said she got up and pushed Joshua again. [REDACTED] said Joshua pushed her to the ground again so she slapped Joshua in the face. [REDACTED] said Joshua blocked her from leaving [REDACTED] room and she slapped him again. [REDACTED] said Joshua then punched her in the face. [REDACTED] said Joshua then threw her on [REDACTED] bed. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] was in the room and in close proximity while the fight occurred. [REDACTED] said the punch hurt and the cut under her left eye was a direct result of the punch.

Joshua said [REDACTED] and she were arguing about their son's nutrition in the kitchen. Joshua said he and [REDACTED] continued to argue upstairs. Joshua said [REDACTED] slapped him twice on the left side of the face. Joshua has redness and some blood on the left side of his face. Joshua said he did not remember his response to [REDACTED] slapping him only that he carried [REDACTED] down the stairs and out of the house. Joshua said [REDACTED] was in the room while the fighting occurred.

[REDACTED] was transported to St. Anthony's North Health Campus by Thornton Fire Department. Doctors at St. Anthony's North signed a form saying [REDACTED] injuries are consistent with Serious Bodily Injury. [REDACTED] said Joshua took her phone from her so she could not call anyone for help. [REDACTED] cell phone was in Joshua's pocket found search incident to arrest.

Joshua was taken into custody and booked in at Thornton Police Department then transported to Adams County Detention Facility.
